## NEW PLANTS ADDED TO THE FALL 2010 POT-GROWN LINER LIST

### FLUTTERBY SERIES OF BUTTERFLY BUSH

*The new Flutterby butterfly bushes are three series of compact-growing buddleia selected to be the best of the new butterfly bushes. All Flutterby Series are low-water needs varieties and grow in Zones 5-10. They are all introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*

*The straight Flutterby Series feature a dense growth habit and continuous blooming from early summer until frost. Height: 3-4 ft. Spread: 4-5 ft.*



#### **Buddleia Flutterby™ Pink (B. 'Podaras #9') PPAF**

With no central leader, this heavy flowering cultivar produces flower panicles that are up to 1.5 ft. long and 4 in. wide. The mid-pink flowers point upright on the plant for a unique butterfly bush display. Blooms do not shatter from handling.

*Flutterby Petite Series has compact, mounded and spreading growth. It features less viable seeds, making it an ecologically responsible option. Height: 1-2 ft. Spread: 1-2 ft.*



#### **Buddleja Flutterby Petite™ Blue Heaven (B. 'Podaras #8') PPAF**

A ground cover selection that challenges all the preconceptions of what a butterfly bush looks like. Blue Heaven has a dense growth habit and continuously blooms from early Summer until frost. Gorgeous silver foliage is fuzzy. Features beautiful blue blooms.

#### **Buddleja Flutterby Petite™ Snow White (B. 'Podaras #15') PPAF**

A compact-mounding selection growing to 12" to 24" and spreading the same. Hardy to -20° F, Snow White blooms from spring through summer. Available in 3½" Pots for spring 2011.

*Flutterby Grande Series is the largest of the Flutterby buddleia. This sterile series doesn't produce seed and was selected for its environmental benefits. It features an upright habit, scented foliage and prolific blooms from early summer until frost. Height: 4-6 ft. Spread: 4-6 ft.*



#### **Buddleja Flutterby Grande™ Peach Cobbler (B. 'Podaras #5') PPAF**

Easy-to-grow accent plant is great for borders, embankments and landscape plantings, as well as large/mixed containers. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. It ships easily and has an outstanding appearance at retail.

Because interspecies crosses have less viable seed, this series was selected and introduced because of its environmental benefits. Upright cultivars are prolific bloomers from early Summer until frost. Beautiful, peach-colored blooms against silvery foliage. Wonderful fragrance.

### **Buxus sempervirens 'Pride of Rochester'**

A slow growing compact boxwood that holds a dark green color all winter. 'Pride of Rochester' grows to 3-4' by the same and hardy to zone 5. Registered by Girard Nursery, Geneva, Ohio in 1987.



### **Callicarpa japonica 'Snow Storm'**

A unique, mounded, spreading shrub with three-season interest. New foliage emerges white, and becomes speckled and eventually green as it matures into the late part of Summer. Beautiful pink flowers bloom in Spring. Purple fruit in Fall make an attractive display into the Winter. Highly sought after by cutting-edge garden designers, this cultivar is a perfect accent for the landscape, as well as large, mixed and small containers. Shade and heat-tolerant plant catches your eye at retail. Hardy to -10° F, growing to 3' to 4' high and wide.



### **Calluna 'Lady in Pink' (C. vulgaris 'Nr 5157') PP#20,529**

### **Calluna 'Lady in Red' (C. vulgaris 'Nr 5163') PP#20,527**

Evergreen shrubs with bushy, mounding growth habit have abundant flowers that begin to bloom in August, and last until January. For patio or garden display, or for use as a colorful house plant, this budblooming variety is deer resistant. Hardy to -10° F, growing 6-18" tall and 8-14" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*

### **Caryopteris clandonensis 'Summer Sorbet' PP#15,935**

Variegated form with dark gray-green leaves with contrasting chartreuse margins. Deciduous shrub with a mounding habit and long shoots of aromatic, lance-shaped foliage and fluffy-looking clusters of blue flowers in late Summer and Autumn. For the perennial border. Hardy to -20° F, growing to 36-42" tall and 30-40" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



### **Cornus sericea 'Bergeson Compact'**

Discovered by Melvin Bergeson growing in a swamp near Gary, MN, the Bergeson Dogwood is distinctive for its dense growth, rich red fall leaf color, and bright red branching. It's 5-6' compact habit with virtually spot free foliage sets it apart from all other dogwoods.



### **Cornus x 'Irish Setter'<sup>TM</sup> (C. racemosa 'J.N. Red Stem')**

Selected from local ecotype seedlings growing at Johnson's Nursery. Irish Setter<sup>TM</sup> has superior resistance to septoria leaf spot, which is very common on this species. Has a beautiful maroon fall color. In winter, the wood from the previous growing season retains a showy, bright red color. Irish Setter<sup>TM</sup> suckers at a lower rate than the species. Hardy to zone 3, 12' tall and wide.



### **Euonymus fortunei SUMMER SUN (E. f. 'Mickaela') PP#16,789**

This variegated evergreen shrub has young shoots that emerge green then turn yellow with deep green margins. Excellent as a groundcover or in group plantings. Also works well in containers where branches will hang over the edge. Heat tolerant. Hardy to -15° F, growing to 16-24" tall and 30-40" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



### **Hydrangea arborescens 'Hayes Starburst'**

A compact growing Smooth Hydrangea. It grows 3-5' and blooms early summer to frost on new growth. The name is very descriptive of the flower—fertile florets with star shaped sterile florets shooting off in all directions. Flowers can be used in fresh or dried arrangements. It grows well with some sun. Hardy to zone 4.



**Hydrangea Double Delights™ STAR GAZER (H x 'Kompeito') PP#20,998**

One of the new generations of reblooming Hydrangeas, this unique lacecap Hydrangea has large flowers with blue centers and white picotee edges against dark green to green foliage blooming spring through frost. Compact habit requires less pruning, making this a low-maintenance plant. Suitable for the shade garden or as a stunning container plant. Perfect for impulse sales at retail. Hardy to  $-20^{\circ}$  F, growing to 36-48" tall and 36-60" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hydrangea Double Delights™ WEDDING GOWN (H. 'Dancing Snow') PP#21,052**

Earlier to bloom than other Hydrangeas, Wedding Gown reblooms until frost. This lacecap Hydrangea has a compact habit that requires less pruning, making this a low-maintenance plant. With beautiful white blooms against dark green to midgreen foliage, it is also suitable for shade gardens, and makes a stunning container plant. Hardy to  $-20^{\circ}$  F, growing to 24-36" tall and 36-60" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hydrangea Double Delights™ Expression (H. m. 'Rie 06') PP#18,393**

Compact Expression, a reblooming Hydrangea, has double pink to blue, mophead flowers that begin to bloom in late Spring, and continue to bloom until frost against dark green foliage. With deadheading, this plant will rebloom in the Summer and Fall. Flowers stay upright during blooming, a significant improvement over other reblooming Hydrangeas. Hardy to  $-20^{\circ}$  F, growing to 36-48" tall and 24-36" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hydrangea Next Generation WEDDING RING (H. 'Fanfare') PPAF**

One of the new generations of reblooming Hydrangeas, Wedding Ring features a beautiful display of white blooms against dark green foliage. This lacecap Hydrangea will enhance the beauty of any garden. Compact habit requires less pruning, making this a low-maintenance plant. Suitable for the shade garden or as a stunning container plant. Blooms in Spring, Summer and Fall. Hardy to  $-20^{\circ}$  F, growing to 24-36" tall and 36-60" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hydrangea paniculata 'Bombshell' PP#21,008**

A garden breakthrough! With a compact growth habit, 'Bombshell' is incredibly well branched. Covered in white flowers against medium green to dark green foliage from early Summer until frost, this cultivar has more flowers per plant than any other Hydrangea paniculata. With its long bloom time and compact habit, 'Bombshell' is a significantly improved plant in all respects. It is low maintenance with little to no pruning needed to keep the plant compact and tidy. Long bloom time also means a long retail display. A remarkable show in most garden settings. Hardy to  $-30^{\circ}$  F, growing to only an incredibly small 18-36" tall and 18-36" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hydrangea 'Sweet Summer' (H. paniculata 'Bokrathirteen') PPAF**

Unique, bright green blooms in mid-Summer hold their bright and refreshing color right into autumn when the blooms change to a rich, deep pink. The flowers are 3 times larger than other cultivars on the market. The Autumn display of green and pink blooms on the same plant is very attractive. Growth habit is upright, so it does not flop in the garden. Easy-to-grow and low-maintenance cultivar is also drought tolerant. This heat and shade-tolerant, mounded shrub is the perfect accent or border plant for beds and the landscape, as well as large mixed containers. Hardy to  $-30^{\circ}$  F, growing to 6-10' tall and wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Hypericum IGNITE™ Scarlet (H. a 'Seicol') PP18,799**

Compact selection has late-Summer blooms that turn into colorful fruit, and combine with dark green foliage for a unique display in gardens and containers. Proven rust-tolerance, and thrives in heat, high night temperatures, humidity and full sun and drought tolerant. Yellow flowers in July and August followed by dark red-orange fruits in the Fall. Hardy to  $-20^{\circ}$  F, growing to 12-36" tall and 12-24" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Lonicera Peaches and Cream (L. periclymenum 'Caprilia Imperial') PPAF**

This fragrant deciduous vine with compact growth habit has flowers that flush a soft pink to a clear, light yellow, and bloom throughout the Summer. Highly tolerant of powdery mildew. Fragrant, Summer-blooming vines make gorgeous displays in the landscape or in containers. Drought and heat tolerant. Hardy to  $-30^{\circ}$  F, growing to 5-6' tall and 20-30" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Lonicera Sweet Tea (L. periclymenum 'Caprilla Cream') PPAF**

Fragrant flowers flush a rich, fluorescent pink opening to a light yellow fading to white, and bloom all Summer on this deciduous vine with a compact growth habit. Suitable for smaller garden and patio containers. Highly tolerant of powdery mildew. Fragrant, Summer-blooming vines make gorgeous displays in the landscape or in containers. Drought and heat tolerant. Hardy to  $-30^{\circ}$  F, growing to 5-6' tall and 20-30" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Magnolia 'Jane' Magnolia (liliflora 'Reflorescens' x stellata 'Waterlily')**

One of "The Girls" group of hybrid magnolias developed at the U.S. National Arboretum. 'Jane' has a spectacular floral display approximately two weeks later than *M. stellata* and *M. x soulangiana*, decreasing the possibility of spring frost damage. Plants grow as multistemmed large shrubs or small trees bearing slightly leathery leaves that stand up well to summer heat and drought. Upright growing habit, 8-12' tall. Hardiness zones 5-8.



**Magnolia virginiana australis**

This native North American sweetbay magnolia has flowers that are solitary, creamy white and lemon-scented late spring to early summer. The semi-evergreen foliage is glossy dark green and silvery underneath. Trees will grow 10 to 20 feet in height in the northern part of its range; 60 feet or more in the southern part of its range. Hardy in zones 5-9.



**Malus FIREBIRD® (M. sargentii 'Select A') PP #12,621**

A new introduction from Michael Yanny at Johnson's Nursery, WI, selected from a block of *M. sargentii* seedlings. Red to pink buds open to sweet smelling white blossoms at the same time that *Viburnum carlesii* is in bloom. It has excellent disease resistance and is harder than most *Malus sargentii*. It will grow to 10' tall and 18' wide. Hardy in zones 3-7.



**Malus sargentii 'Tina'**

A dwarf form of *M. sargentii* that is very disease resistant. Red buds open to single white flowers in the spring that cover the branches then develop small red fruit. On their own root, 'Tina' is a small shrub slowly growing to only 4-5'. Hardy in zones 4-7.



**Physocarpus Lemon Candy (P. op. 'Podaras 3') PPAF**

Rich, bright yellow foliage with chartreuse undertones. Persistent color from early spring until Fall. Small white blooms in Spring. Compact habit and easy to maintain. Hardy to zone 3, growing to 36-40" tall and 24-36" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Physocarpus opulifolius Ruby Spice (P. o. 'Tuilad') PP#18,660**

This cultivar is unique due to its rich pink flowers that bloom in Spring. With a compact growth habit and dark burgundy foliage, Ruby Spice is an attractive hedge in the landscape. United States native shrub is adaptable to many regions within the United States. Red foliage on this low-maintenance plant persists from Spring until Fall. Hardy to zone -40° F, growing to 6-7' tall and 3-4' wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Pieris japonica PASSION™ (P. j. 'Ralto') PP#19,331**

Brilliant, red flowers have a clear white coloration on the top of each. Flowers are born in great profusion, and variegated foliage is glossy and dark green. It has a better branching habit, and is more resistant to diseases common in the family. Showy, pendulous flowers are 6 inches long, and bloom for 2 to 3 weeks in late March and early April. Fruits throughout the Fall. Hardy to zone -10° F, growing to 4-5' tall and 2-3' wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Salix repens 'Bridal Rice'**

Low growing, sprawling willow with short, narrow, gray-blue leaves. The tiny pussy willow flowers that emerge in early spring resemble white rice grains. Drought and salt tolerant. Height to 18" x 6-8' spread. Hardy to zone 4.



**Sorbaria sorbifolia 'Sem' PP#16,336**

Branching stems attractively clothed in pairs of finely toothed leaflets are decorated in Summer with panicles of creamy white flowers. This novel, dwarf variety features appealing bronze foliage in Spring and Fall. Useful as a low hedge, it is an improvement from older Sorbaria varieties with its compact, better branched and more dense habit. Hardy to zone -30° F, growing to 4-6' tall and 4-6' wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Spiraea Pink-a-licious™ (S. fritschiana 'Select A')**

Pink flowering form of *S. fritschiana*. Can have an outstanding yellow-apricot/pink-red fall color. The colors of a fruit salad! Excellent dense branching habit 3' tall and wide. Hardy to zone 3.



**Spiraea fritschiana 'Summer Clouds'**

Our own selection of *Spiraea fritschiana*. Prolific white "clouds" of flowers early summer and nice yellow/orange fall foliage makes an outstanding addition to the border garden or perennial bed. Dense branching habit 4'x4'. Hardy to zone 3.



**Thuja FOREVER GOLDY (T. p. '4ever') PP #19,267**

This “ever golden” compact shrub grows quickly into a stunning display of gold-yellow foliage that will not shed. Features unique red stems during Fall and Winter. Excellent for planting in a container on the patio, or at the back of a border. Great orange color in Fall. Hardy to zone  $-30^{\circ}$  F, growing to 15-20' tall and 30-36" wide. *Introduced by Ball Ornamentals.*



**Viburnum Sugar n' Spice™ (V. carlesii J.N. 'Select S')**

Sugar n' Spice is a heavy flowering cultivar with the same sweet-spiced, floral fragrance for which the species is known. The flower clusters (cymes) are smaller than average, but are much more plentiful throughout the body of the plant. The plant was selected at Johnson's Nursery, Inc. from open-pollinated *Viburnum carlesii* seedlings. Ultimate size is 8' x 8', hardy to zone 4.
